

William J. Knight Scholarship in Computer and Information Sciences

Purpose:

The William J. Knight Scholarship has been established to provide current undergraduate and graduate students majoring in Computer and Information Sciences at IU South Bend with financial assistance in completing their degrees. The basis for the scholarship is demonstrated potential for academic excellence in Computer and Information Sciences. The Scholarship will be awarded annually through the Computer Science Scholarship Committee.

Application requirements:

The **William J. Knight Scholarship** is used to provide a competitive scholarship. This scholarship provides financial support for computer science students at IU South Bend with potential for excellent academic achievement. Applications are available at the Department of Computer and Information Sciences and on the web at www.cs.iusb.edu/scholarships/wknight.pdf. **The award is open to current undergraduate and graduate students as well as promising incoming students (see below for details). Application deadline is April 1.**

Applicant must declare an intent to complete a computer science degree, complete **an application form** and provide a **personal statement** regarding their academic goals and what they hope to accomplish with their education.

Award:

Depending on the number of applicants and available funds, each year the award amount is determined by the computer science awards committee. A typical award will be between \$500 and \$3,000 per academic year. The awards committee may choose to disburse the funds as follows:

- 1) Cash award (one or two installments per semester)
- 2) Tuition reimbursement (two installments per year)
- 3) Funds for attending research conferences (approved by the student’s advisor)
